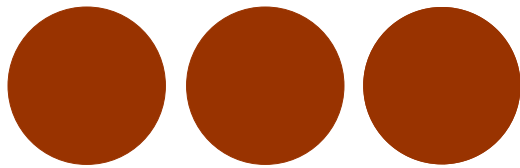

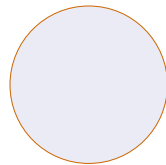

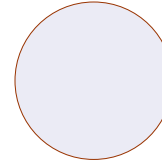

Catholic Social Services (CSS), accredited by the national Council on Accreditation, is one of the largest social service agencies in Alaska. CSS was incorporated in 1966 with the mission to compassionately serve the poor, strengthen individuals and families, and advocate for a just community.

CSS operates 10 programs including two emergency shelters, two homes for teens, a food pantry, supportive housing and mobile case management, an adoption and pregnancy support program, services for individuals with disabilities, a day habilitation program for young adults with developmental disabilities, and a refugee resettlement and immigration program.
